## 1 Use Excel Tables: Make data easier for Power Query to read


How?

For easy referencing, rename the table "USTransactions" via the Formulas tab > Name Manager



## 2 Load data: Data tab > From Table/Range




**Bonus Tip**

## 3 Remove Unwanted Columns




**Bonus Tips**  
1. Steps performed in the Power Query editor do not alter the source data.  
2. Steps taken can be reused on new data with same columns.


## 4 Split Columns by Delimiter: Split Location into City & State




## 6 Change Data Type: Accurate data types are essential for accurate analysis



## 5 Standardize Data: Change case uniformly, remove unwanted characters




## 7 Duplicate Query: Reuse same steps on new data



**? No need to redo data cleaning!**  
On refresh, new data gets pulled in & cleaned automatically

## 8 Append Query: Combine data from multiple sources into one sheet.



**What Next?**  
Append queries adds all data under one another.  
Close & Load the Power Query Editor to load the transformed data to Excel grid!

**Must-Know:**  
- Column names must be identical in all data sources  
- Power Query is case sensitive
