1 Identify & Remove Duplicates: Avoid wrong analysis

How?

1. Select the column with duplicate data > Home tab > Conditional Formatting > Highlight Cell Rules > Duplicate Values
2. Assess the highlighted duplicate values
3. Data tab > Remove Duplicates > Delete duplicate values

1. Identify duplicates

2. Arrive at duplicate-free data

5 Use Appropriate Number Formats: Minimize clutter

Best Practices

1. Use "Short Date format" if time component is not required
2. Avoid Currency format – Use "Number" or "General" formats to declutter currency symbol from each row of your data
3. CTRL+1 > Select "Number" format > Check "Use 1000 Separator"
4. Use the currency symbol in the column headers

6 Find & Replace: Replace unwanted values in one-go

4 Handle Errors with IFERROR: Avoid messy errors

How?

1. Select data > CTRL+T to insert table (Optional step - enables easy-to-read structured references)
2. Wrap your formula in the IFERROR function to avoid error message when dealing with missing or non-numeric values such as "inf"
